Project: **Salisbury Road Primary School**
Client: **Plymouth City Council – Cornwall Council Capital Projects Framework**
Value: **£527,000**
Location: **Plymouth**

The project involved the refurbishment of a redundant building on site of the fully operational Salisbury Road Primary School. The building, which has been partially used by the Plymouth City Council in recent years, now houses six Reception and Year 1 classes, together with ancillary spaces such as WCs, group rooms and offices. We worked very closely with the staff of the school to ensure minimum disruptions to the normal school operations and to ensure all the school's requirements were met at all times. As a way of encouraging the children to take an interest in the building work, a Health and Safety poster competition was held to raise awareness of being close to a construction site. As a result four lucky pupils took home shiny new bikes after winning our competition. In another community initiative aimed at helping the school, we sponsored the provision of 30 Key Stage 2 Maths and Crossword Puzzle books.
